The obligation for companies to offer the option of reusable packaging has now been in force in Germany for three months. A reason for celebration – and good news for the Blue Angel because we have already been certifying reusable systems for a number of years. It was thus even nicer for us to award the Blue Angel to two suppliers of reusable systems in the first third of the year: German Environment Minister Steffi Lemke (BMUV) presented a certificate to EDEKA on 11 January and awarded another one a week later as part of Green Week to FairCup for its new products FairBox, FairPac and FairMax.
